

**NOTICE OF A WIND ENERGY CONVERSION SYSTEM (WECS) PERMIT
AMENDMENT TO PREVIOUSLY PUBLISHED TIME AND PLACE**

ConnectGen Albany County, LLC gives notice of an application for a WECS Permit to construct and operate the up to 504 megawatt (MW) commercial wind energy project (Rail Tie Wind Project), intended to include 120 wind turbines (94 turbines are on private land and 26 on State land) in Albany County. The project proposed in southeastern Albany County, Wyoming encompasses approximately 26,000 acres on private and State lands near Tie Siding, Wyoming. This project is proposed within T14N R72W, T13N R71W, T13N R72W, T13N R73W, T12N R72W, and T12N R73W in Albany County. The project site will be accessed primarily from U.S. Highway 287. From here the project will use Hermosa Road (County Road [CR] 222), Pumpkin Vine Road (CR 241), Cherokee Park road (CR 31), Sportsman Lake Road, Boulder Ridge Road (CR 319), Dale Creek Road (private), and an unnamed paved turn off of U.S. Highway 287. Interstate 80 will provide additional access to the north part of the project via Vedauwoo Road (CR 700) and Monument Road (CR 234). Transmission lines associated with this project are within the project boundaries. The transmission lines and other related facilities are outlined in the application's preliminary site plan.

A public hearing will be held on the proposed WECS permit by the Board of County Commissioners on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. in the District Court Room on the 3rd Floor of the Albany County Courthouse. The public may attend in person or via Zoom. The public is invited to submit written comments to the Albany County Planning Office or directly to the Board of County Commissioners <https://www.co.albany.wy.us/463/Public-Comment> prior to the meeting.
